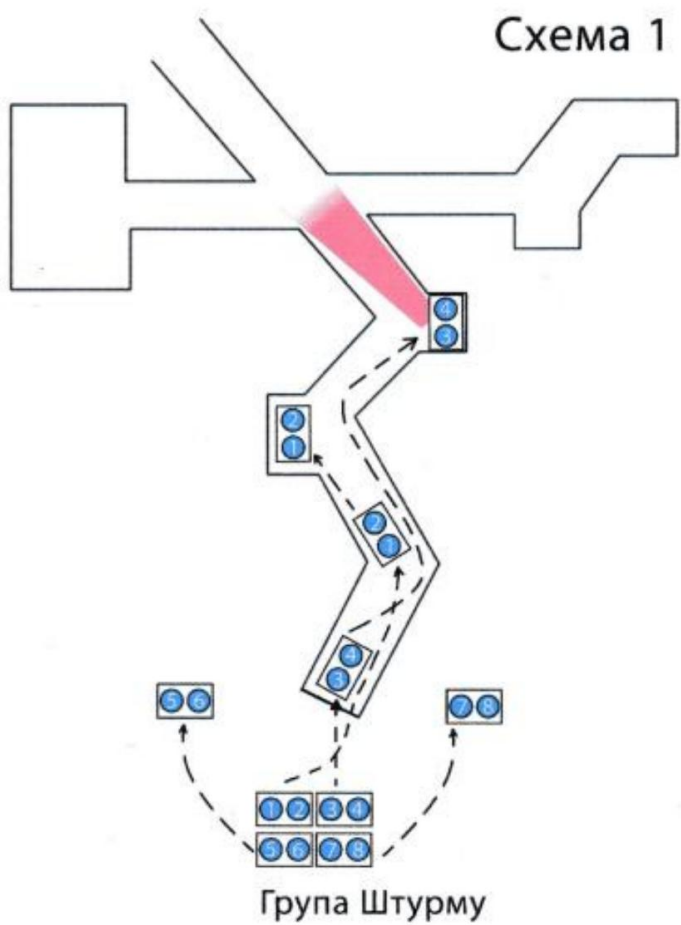




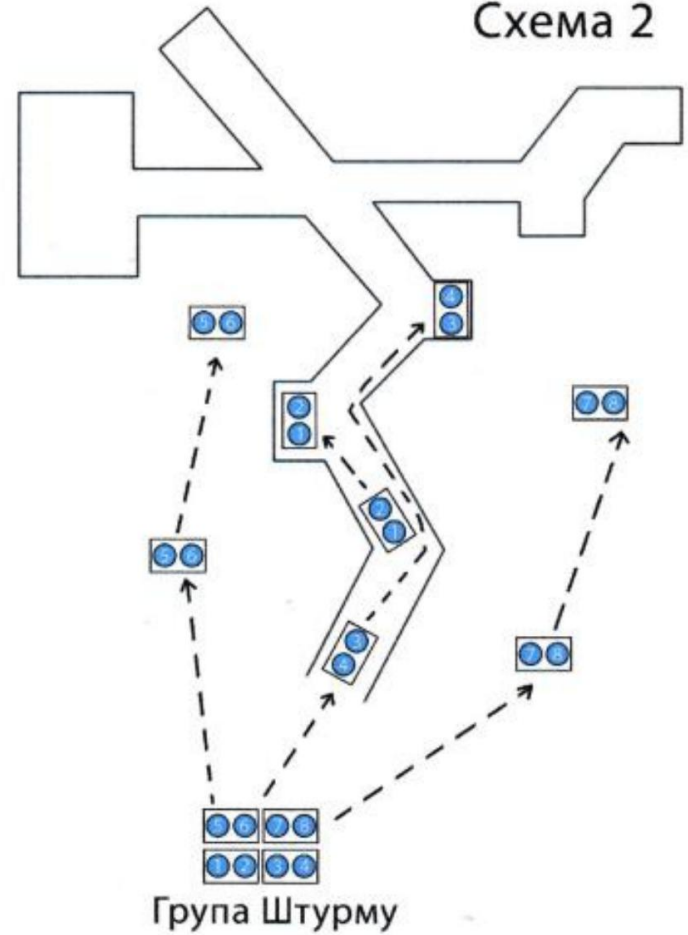
# ASSAULT OF THE TRENCHES

### **Actions of the assault group according to option 1:**

#### **working out the first floor under the cover of the second group (Scheme 1)**

##### ***The group consists of 12 people: 8***

people form the main assault group; 4 people belong to the fire support group. **Equipment: main assault group** - assault rifles, hand

grenades; fire support group - assault rifles, 7.62 mm machine guns and underbarrel grenade launchers (GP 25 or M320A1). Eight people are stationed on the first floor in pairs in positions at a distance of visual contact, but protected from the enemy.

Their task includes the complete clearing of trenches from the enemy, the detection of mine- explosive devices, as well as the storming of dugouts and their subsequent clearing.

**The fire support group** occupies positions on the right and left sides of the trench, providing flank cover for maximum suppression of enemy fire with the help of machine guns. They move along the line of the trench, maintaining visual contact with the main assault group. This option allows for a more efficient and safe assault operation by carefully coordinating the actions of the main group and the fire support group.

### **Actions of the assault group 2 option:**

#### **development of the first and second floors of the trench part. (Scheme 2) *Group***

##### ***consisting of 12 people: 8***

people are the main strike group. 4 men

reserve group. Weapons:

assault rifles, hand machine guns (mini mi) and hand grenades, smoke grenades. ***The main group: 4***

men work on the

first floor in two pairs at a distance of visual contact but are behind cover. The task of the subgroup is to clear the enemy's trench, identify foxholes and mine-explosive devices, as well as storm dugouts and their

cleaning.

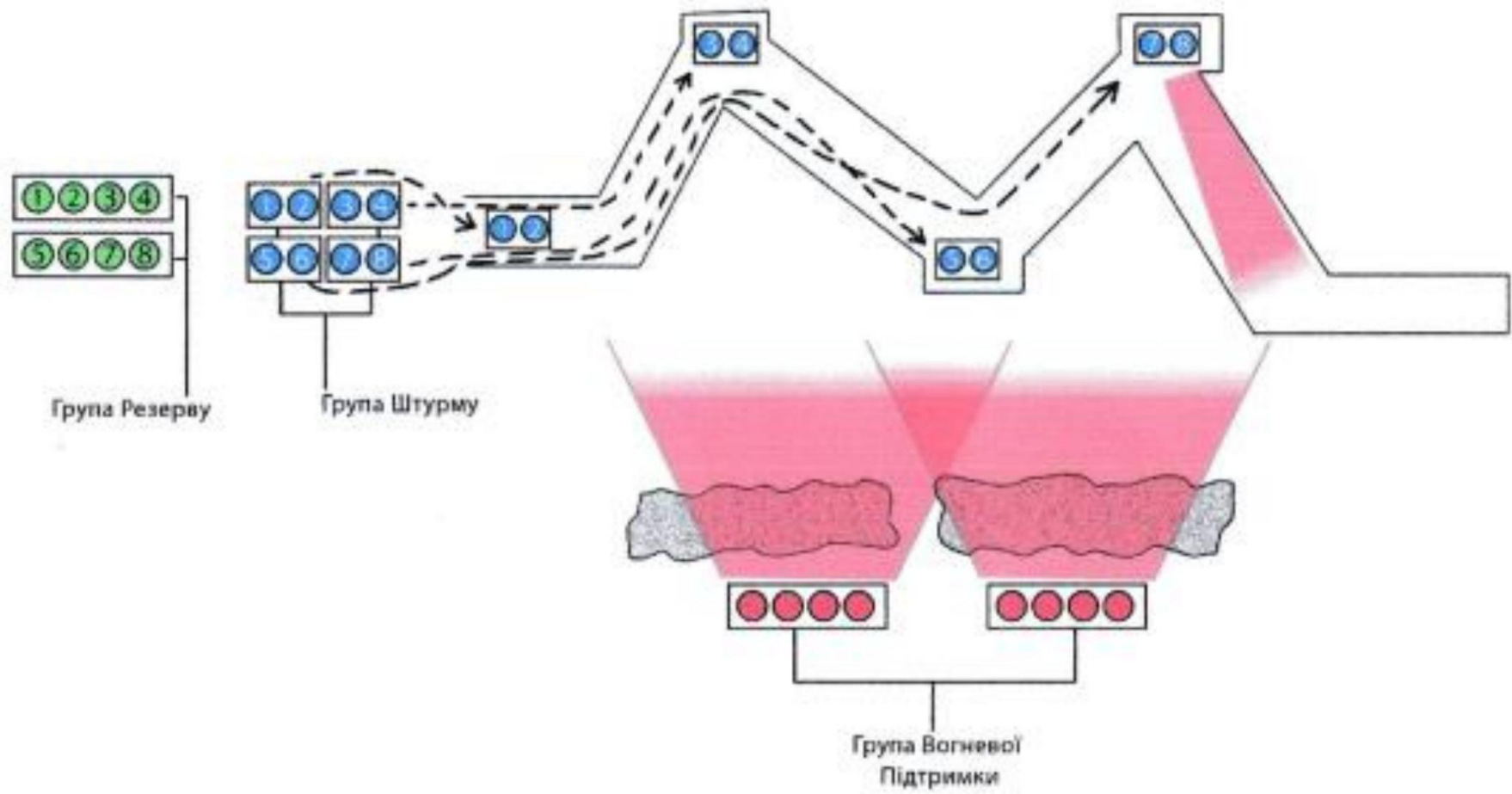
2 men move up the second floor from the left side of the trench, 2 men move up the second floor from the right side of the trench, taking cover with the parapet. The movement can be carried out both on the inner part of the parapet and on the outside. The task is to cover the group of the 1st floor and fire control of the far sector, as well as areas of the trench that pose a threat to the group of the 1st floor. The movement of the assault group is carried out constantly to demoralize the enemy forces and prevent them from regrouping and seizing the initiative. ***The closing group*** consisting of four people

is a reserve or evacuation group, can supplement or replace anyone from the assault group, replenish the BC and provide first aid in case of injury according to the protocol under fire. ***The reserve group*** does not

evacuate the wounded to a safe zone, as the priority task of the group is

to storm the trench. A separate evacuation group carries out the evacuation of the wounded.

## **Actions of the assault group according to the 3rd option: working out the enemy's trenches under the cover of the fire support group (Scheme 3)**

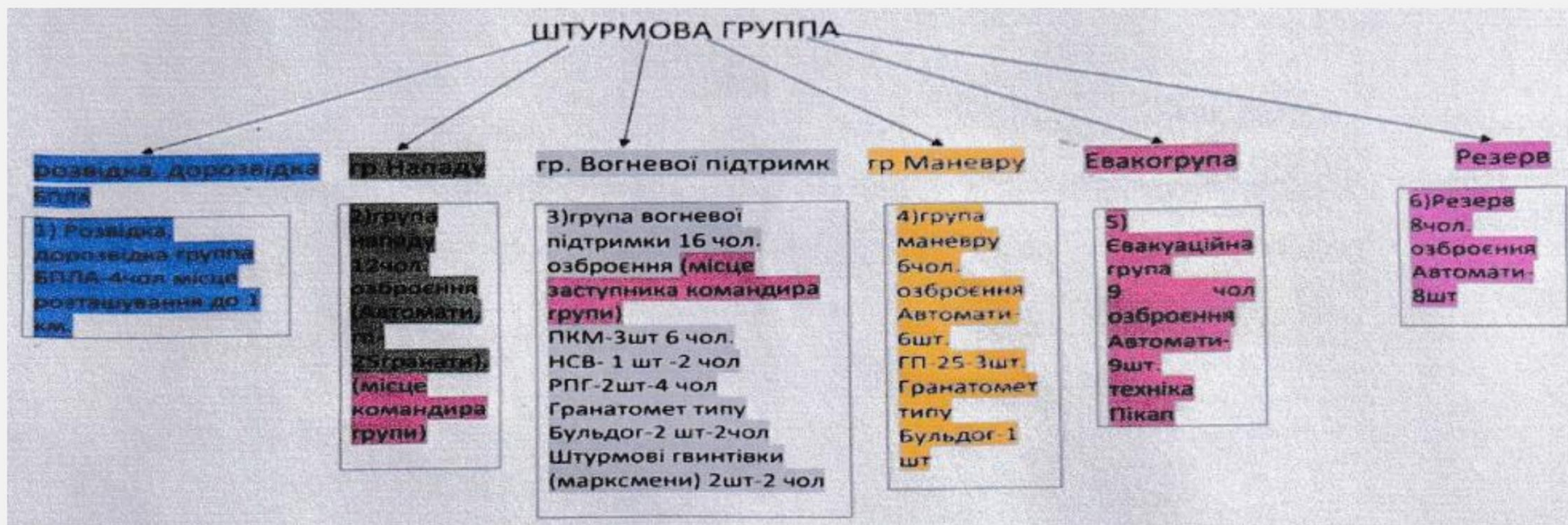
***The group consists of (8+8 people) two small tactical groups.***

***The fire support group consists of 6 to 12 people.***

***The first small tactical group (vanguard)*** works on the first floor of consisting of four pairs at the distance of visual contact, but are behind their task is to completely clear the enemy's trenches, detect mine-explosive devices, as well as storm the dugouts and clear them.

***A second small tactical group (reserve)*** is also located on the first floor dug in as part of four pairs at a distance of visual contact from each other and at some distance from the first group (vanguard). Their task is to cover flanks from the trench part.

***The VP group*** occupies positions predetermined by the reconnaissance group. their main the task of supporting the main or reserve assault group with transfer of fire along the line of trenches.



**The assault squad consists of the following tactical groups**

**Reconnaissance and additional reconnaissance** - will consist of 4 UAV operators and their assistants. Location of the group at a distance of no more than 1 km from the object of the assault. The task of the group includes identifying the number of enemy personnel, identifying hidden firing points, advance routes to the target and probable points of breakthrough, observation and leading the group during the assault. Weapons: small arms and defensive hand grenades.

**The attack group** consists of 12 people. The main task of the group is: Approach, break through, clear and fix on the defined lines for the defense of the position. Armament: small arms, hand grenades, underbarrel grenade launcher.



**The fire support group** consists of 16 people. The group's main task is to suppress enemy positions with barrage fire and create a corridor for the safe entry of the attack group. Armament: small arms, hand grenades, underbarrel grenade launcher, machine gun, grenade launcher.

**The maneuver group** consists of 6 people. The main task of the group is: False maneuvering in order to mislead the enemy. When a weak area of the enemy's defense is identified, they carry out a breakthrough, clearing and securing. Armament: small arms, hand grenades, underbarrel grenade launcher.

**The evacuation group** consists of 9 people. The main task of the group is: Evacuation of the wounded and delivery of BC to the specified destination points.

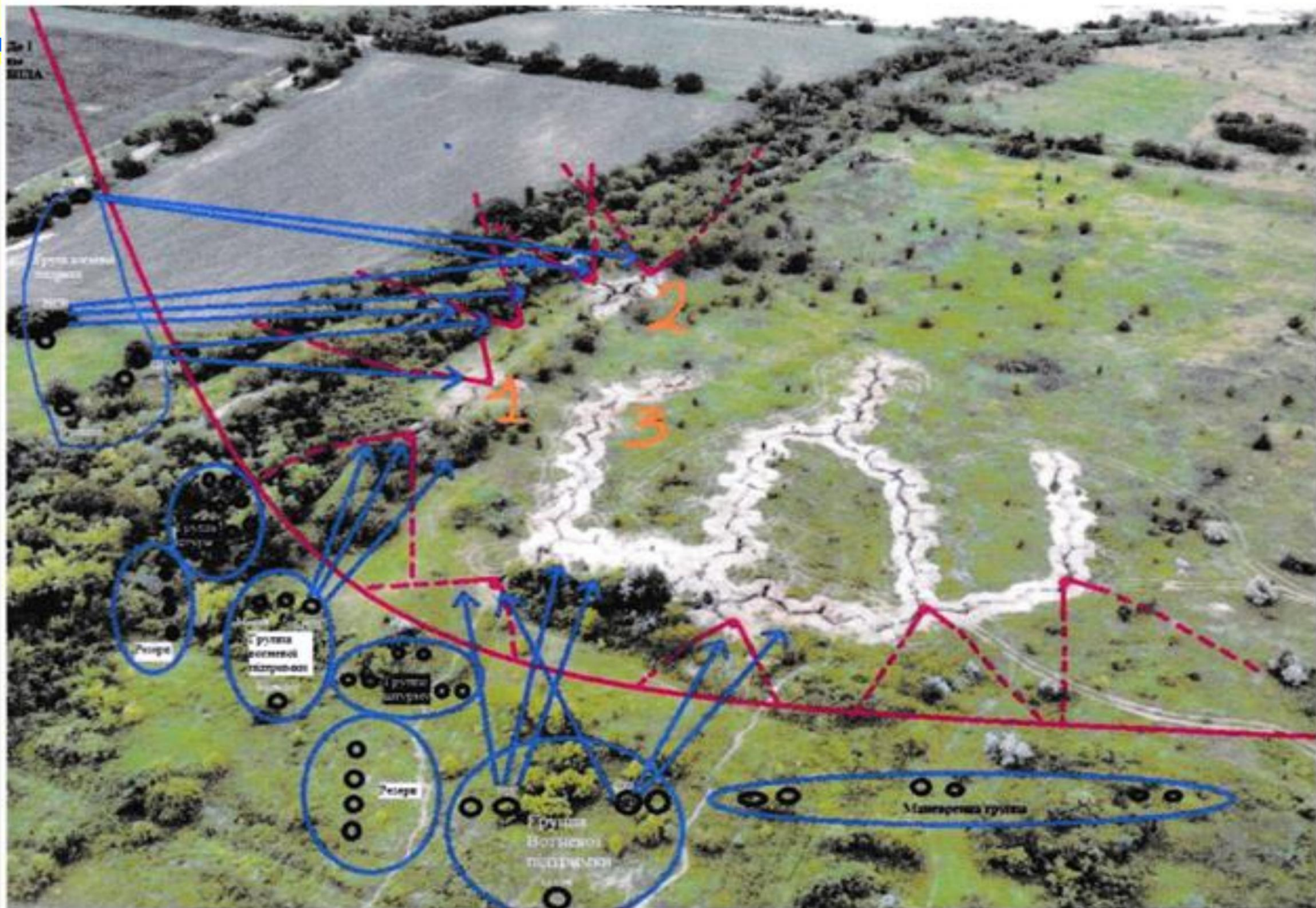
Armament: small arms.

**Reserve group** - consists of 8 people. The main task of the group is: If necessary, replenish the attack group.

Armament: small arms, hand grenades, underbarrel grenade launcher.

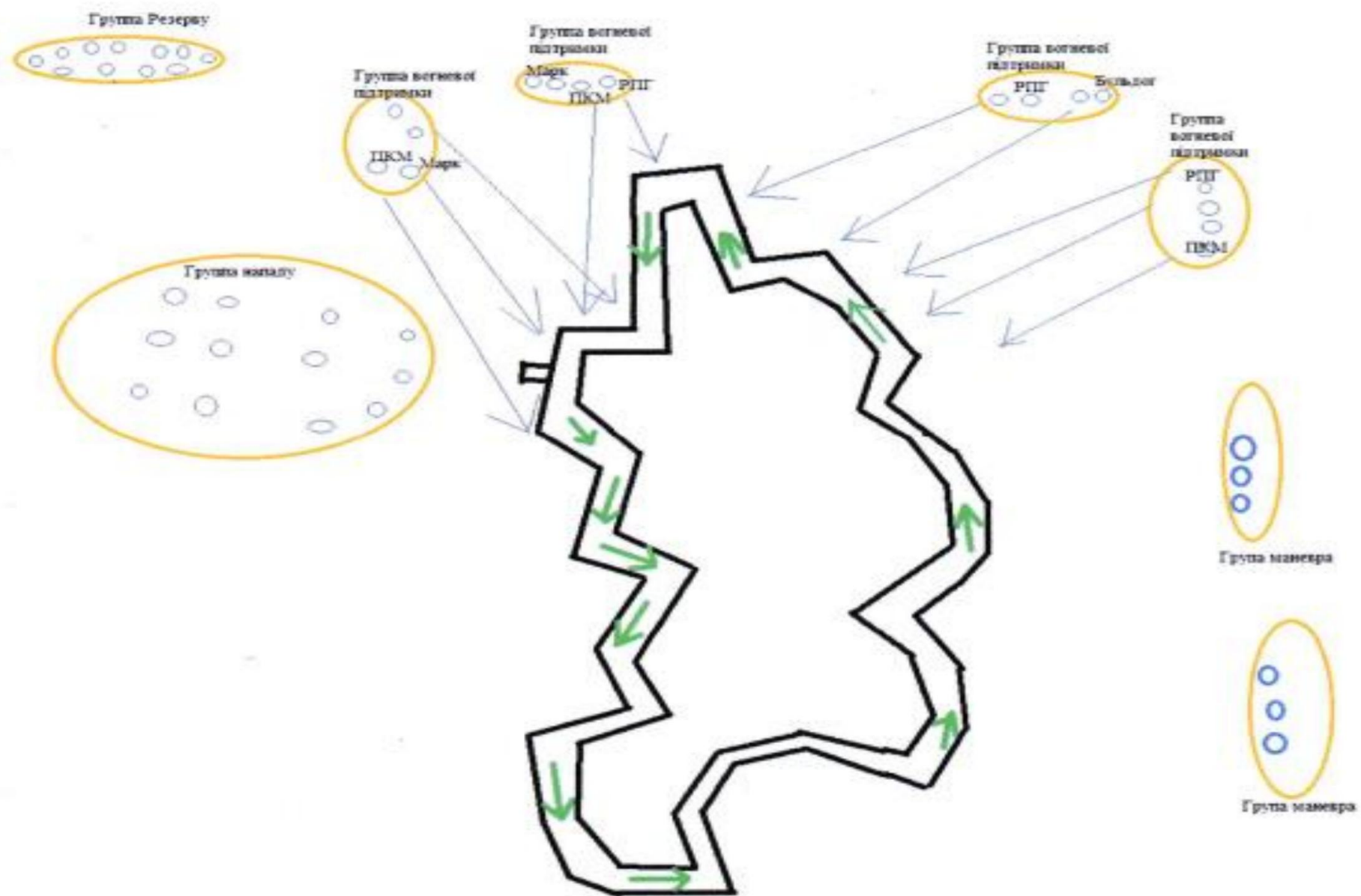
